





# 1. 基本安全警告

## 2.3 使用什么制作牛奶/植物奶基底饮品

- •该机器既可用于制作牛奶饮品,也可用于制作植物奶饮品。
- •请不要使用生奶。
- •仅使用巴氏杀菌、超高温灭菌奶或植物奶,并 依照厂商指示的储存方法保存。
- •说明书中描述的清洁方法无法保证完全去除过敏原。

# 3.使用之前

## 3.1 机器检查

打开包装后,确保机器表面完好且没有被损坏,同时所有的配件齐全。如果机器存在明显的损坏,切勿使用该机器。请与德龙授权的售后服务中心联系。

#### 3.2 机器安装

安装机器的时候,应该重视以下安全警告:

- •本电器会释放出热量,因此将机器放置于工作台时,机器表面、侧面及靠墙部分需留出至少3厘米的空间,咖啡机上方需要留出至少15厘米的空间。
- •若有水渗入,会损坏机器。切勿将该机器放置 在水龙头或者水槽附近。
- •若机器中的水结冰会损坏机器。切勿将机器安放在一个室温可能低于零度的房间内。
- 电源线切勿放置在尖锐物质的边缘或接触热的物体表面(如电热板),这样会损坏电源线。

#### 3.3 机器连接

## 3.4 机器设置

# 4. 清洁和保养

# 4.3 水箱的清洁与保养

- •定期清洁:请按照产品说明书,每30天清洁一次水箱。
- •制作热饮:水箱中的水至少每3天更换一次。
- •冷萃功能(如配备此功能): 在制作冷萃饮品前,请清空水箱,彻底冲洗并重新注入新鲜饮用水。

# 4.5 牛奶容器的清洁与保养(如包含此部件)

- •按照产品说明书所述的清洗程序拆卸牛奶容器 并清洁所有部件。
- •如果牛奶或植物奶饮品残留在牛奶容器中,在 执行自动"清洁"操作后(如配备此功能),可将 牛奶容器置于冰箱储存以便下次使用。热牛奶容 器在冰箱中的存放时间不得超过2天;冷牛奶容 器在冰箱中的存放时间不得超过1天。超过上述 存放时间后,应排空牛奶容器,拆卸所有部件并 按照说明书的指示清洁所有部件。
- •使用后,如果牛奶容器已空或已放置在冰箱外超过30分钟,应倒掉任何剩余的产品,拆卸所有部件并按照说明书的指示清洁所有部件。



# 9.菜单设置

# 19.4 清洁咖啡盛渣盒

- The machine can be used both with both cow's milk and plant-based beverages.
- Do not use raw milk.
- Use only pasteurized or UHT milk or plant-based beverages stored according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- The cleaning methods described in the instructions do not guarantee the complete removal of allergens.
- In case of allergies or suspected allergies and/or intolerances, make sure that your machine has not already been used with types of milk or plant-based beverages that contain allergens you are allergic to or substances to which you are intolerant.

#### BEFORE USE

# 3.1 Checking the appliance

After removing the packaging, make sure the product is complete and undamaged and that all accessories are present. Do not use the appliance if it is visibly damaged. Contact De'Longhi Customer Services.

# 3.2 Installing the appliance

When you install the appliance, you should respect the following safety warnings:

- The appliance gives off heat. After positioning the appliance on the worktop, leave a space of at least 3 cm between the surfaces of the appliance and the side and rear walls and at least 15 cm above the coffee maker.
- Water penetrating the appliance could cause damage. Do not place the appliance near taps or sinks.
- The appliance could be damaged if the water it contains freezes. Do not install the appliance in a room where the temperature could drop below freezing point.

 Arrange the power cord in such a way that it cannot be damaged by sharp edges or contact with hot surfaces (e.g. electric hot plates).

#### 3.3 Connecting the appliance

Check that the mains power supply voltage corresponds to that indicated on the rating plate on the bottom of the appliance. Connect the appliance to an efficiently earthed and correctly installed socket with a minimum current rating of 10 A only. If the power socket does not match the plug on the appliance, have the socket replaced with a suitable type by a qualified professional.

#### 3.4 Setting up the appliance

The first time the machine is used, the water circuit will be empty and operation could be very noisy. The noise becomes less as the circuit fills.

#### 4. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Carefully perform the regular cleaning of the machine and its accessories as indicated in the instructions for use provided and/or prompted by the display or warning lights of the appliance itself
- Do not use solvents, abrasive or alkaline cleaners, or alcohol to clean the appliance, as they could damage it: use a soft cloth and, where applicable, neutral detergent.

### 4.1 Cleaning before first use

#### 4.2 Prolonged non-use of the appliance

- If the machine is not going to be used for a period longer than 3 days, empty the water tank and use the "circuit draining" function (if available on the model)
- When switching the machine on after 3 or more days without use, dispense, without consuming, the following beverages: hot water, steam, hot coffee, and a cold extraction beverage (if included in the model).

# 4.3 Cleaning and maintenance of the water tank.

- Regular cleaning: Clean the water tank every 30 days following the instructions provided.
- Beverages served hot: The water in the tank should be changed at least every 3 days.

 Cold extraction technology (if included in the model): Before making cold extraction drinks, empty out the water tank, rinse thoroughly and refill with fresh potable water.

# 4.4 Cleaning and maintenance of the brewing unit (if removable in the model)

 This should be cleaned every 30 days following the instructions provided.

# 4.5 Cleaning and maintenance of the milk carafe (if included in the model)

- Disassemble the milk carafe and clean all components, following the washing procedure shown in the instructions provided.
- If milk or plant-based beverages remain in the milk carafe, after performing the automatic "Clean" operation (if available), the milk carafe can be stored in the refrigerator for later use. Do not exceed 2 days of storage in the refrigerator for hot milk carafes and 1 day for cold milk carafes. After this period, empty the milk carafe, disassemble, and clean all components as described in the instructions provided.
- After use, if the milk carafe is empty or has been left out of the refrigerator for more than 30 minutes, empty any remaining product, disassemble, and clean all the components as described in the instructions provided.

#### 9.1 Rinsing

Use this function to deliver hot water from the coffee spouts (A13), to clean and heat the appliance's internal circuit.

Place a container with a minimum capacity of 200 ml under the spouts (fig. 10).

To enable the function, proceed as follows:

- 1. Enter the setting menù by pressing {O} (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Rinsing" is displayed;
- Press "Yes" to start delivery. After a few seconds, hot water is delivered to clean and heat the appliance's internal circuit.
- To stop rinsing, press "Stop" or wait for rinsing to stop automatically.

#### Please note:

 If the appliance is not used for more than 3 days, you should clean and fill the water tank with fresh potable

- water. We strongly recommend to perform 2-3 rinses before brewing your drink.
- After rinsing, it is normal for the grounds container (A8) to contain water.

### 9.2 Descaling

For instructions on descaling, see section "19. Descaling".

#### 9.3 Water filter

For instructions on the filter (D4), see section "21. Water softener filter".

# 9.4 Connectivity

Use this function to enable or disable connectivity. Proceed as follows:

- 1. Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Connectivity" is displayed;
- Press "Yes".
- Enable the Wi-Fi connection and remote control (via the De'Longhi Coffee Link mini program). The PIN is automatically created when a device is connecting to the machine.
- 5. Press "Next" to see the identification data of the machine
- Press "<" to save the new selection and go back to the settings menu.
- 7. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (B).

On the homepage, the symbol (C4) indicating the connection status alternates with the other symbols (e.g. descaling, etc.)

#### Please note:

- If the remote connection is off, a number of the functions in the mini-program will not be available (e.g. drink preparation).
- If you change the name or password of the Wi-Fi network, or if you connect to a new Wi-Fi network, you will need to perform the reset procedure as described below:
- 1. Proceed as described above from point 1 to point 3;
- Press "Reset";

- 3. Press "OK" to confirm cancellation of the network settings;
- Connect with the mini program again and select the new credentials.

#### 9.5 General

- Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- Scroll through the pages until "General" is displayed;
   Here you can enable or disable the following functions with a simple touch:
- "Beep sound": when enabled, the appliance beeps whenever an operation is performed.
- "Energy saving": use this function to enable or disable energy saving. When enabled, the function reduces energy consumption in compliance with European regulations.
   is displayed on the homepage to show it is active.
- 3. Press "X" to save the new selection and go back to the homepage (C).

#### 9.6 Auto-off

Auto-off can be set so that the appliance goes off after 15 or 30 minutes, or 1 or 3 hours of inactivity.

To programme auto-off, proceed as follows:

- 1. Enter the setting menù by pressing {O} (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Auto-off" is displayed;
- Select the desired time interval (15 or 30 minutes, or 1 or 3 hours).
- Press "X" to save the new selection and go back to the homepage (C).

# 9.7 Support

Scan the QR-Code to acced manual and get supporto. Press "X" to go back to the homepage. (C)

# 9.8 Grind & Empty

To empty the coffee grinder, grind the remaining beans away:

- Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Grind & Empty" is displayed;
- Press "Read more";
- Rotate the bean hopper (A1) to the 'unlock' position (fig. 12) and leave it there until the operation finishes;
- 5. Press "Start": the machine grinds the remaining beans in the grinder;





- Once finished, remove the bean hopper and insert the other one (see "6. Setting up the appliance") or put the grinder protection lid (D7) (fig. 13);
- 7. The appliance goes back to the homepage (C).

### 9.9 Milk carafe cleaning

The appliance proposes a tutorial on a deep cleaning of the carafe to ensure its proper functioning over the time.

- Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- Scroll through the pages until "Milk carafe cleaning" is displayed;
- 3. Press "Next" or "Back" to read the tips.
- 4. At the last slide, press "Ok" to go back to the setting menu.
- 5. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

#### Please note:

Refer to "19.11 Complete cleaning of the milk carafes (E)".

### 9.10 Coffee temperature

To change the temperature of the water used to make the coffee, proceed as follows:

- 1. Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- Scroll through the pages until "Coffee temperature" is displayed;
- Press "Set";
- 4. Select the required temperature from those proposed;
- Press "<" to save the new selection and go back to the settings menu.
- 6. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

#### Please note:

Varying the temperature has most effect for long drinks.

# Bean Adapt Technology -(1)-:

We suggest you access Bean Adapt Technology in the Coffee Link mini program to adjust this parameter to an appropriate setting for the coffee beans used.

#### 9.11 Statistics

This displays statistics relating to the machine. To view the statistics, proceed as follows:

1. Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);

- Scroll through the pages until "Statistics" and the principal statistics are displayed. To view more information, press "Read more";
- 3. Press "<" to go back to the settings menu.
- 4. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

#### 9.12 Languages

To change the language on the homepage, proceed as follows:

- 1. Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Languages" is displayed;
- Press "Set":
- Press the flag corresponding to the language you want to set. The display is immediately updated with the selected language;
- Press "<" to save the new selection and go back to the settings menu;
- 6. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

### 9.13 Day and time

To change the day and time on the homepage, proceed as follows:

- 1. Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Day and time" is displayed;
- Press "Set";
- Select "Set the time zone": scroll to select your time zone. Press "Ok",
- Select "Set day and time": scroll to set or enable synchronization via Wi-fi;
- 6. Press "<" to go back to the settings menu.
- 7. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

#### 9.14 Grinder setting

The appliance proposes a tutorial on how to adjust grinding correctly for best results:

- Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- Scroll through the pages until "Grinder setting" is displayed;
- Press "Read more" to consult the tutorial on how to adjust the grinding coarseness. Press "Next" or "Back" to read the tips.
- 4. At the last slide, press "Ok" to go back to the setting menu.
- 5. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

#### Please note:

- After carrying out the above procedure, we recommend making at least 3 coffees before adjusting again. If the coffee is still not brewed correctly, repeat the procedure.
- The grinding coarseness regulator (A2) must only be turned when the coffee grinder is in operation during the initial phase of coffee preparation.

We suggest you access Bean Adapt Technology in the Coffee Link mini program to adjust this parameter to an appropriate setting for the coffee beans used.

#### 9.15 Water hardness

To change the water hardness, proceed as follows:

- 1. Test the water hardness proceeding as describer on ""6. Setting up the appliance" "Test water hardness".
- 2. Enter the setting menù by pressing  $\{\widetilde{O}\}$  (C5).
- 3. Scroll through the pages until "Water hardness". Press "Set".
- 4. Select the level corresponding to the test.
- 5. Press "<" to go back to the settings menu.
- 6. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

#### 9.16 Drain water

To avoid the water in the circuit freezing if the appliance is to be left idle for a long period of time, or before taking it to customer services, we recommend emptying the water circuit.

Proceed as follows:

- 1. Enter the setting menù by pressing {O} (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Drain water" is displayed;
- 3. Press "Yes" to start the guided procedure;
- Extract, empty and replace the grounds container (A8) and drip tray (A12) (fig. 14), then press "Next";



- 5. Insert the spout (D5) on the connector (A14) (fig. 5);
- Position a 0,2 I container under the spouts (fig. 10). Press "Next";
- The appliance performs a rinse cycle with hot water from the coffee spouts (A13);
- At the end of rinsing, extract the water tank (A7) (fig. 2) and empty;
- 9. If present, remove the water softener filter (D4) from the water tank and press "Next";
- Put the empty water tank back in the appliance and press "Next".
- 11. Confirm you are ready to start and press "Yes".
- Wait for the appliance to empty the circuit; (Important: hot water from the spouts!). As the water circuit empties,

the appliance could become noisier. This is part of normal operation.

- 13. When the circuit is empty, extract and empty the drip tray, put back in the appliance and press "Next";
- 14. Press "Ok". The appliance goes off (standby).
- 15. Unplug the appliance.

The next time the appliance is turned on, follow the instructions in section "6. Setting up the appliance".

#### 9.17 Default values

This resets all menu settings and user customisation back to the default values (with the exception of the language, which remains as set, and the statistics).

Proceed as follows:

- Enter the setting menù by pressing (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages until "Default values" is displayed;
- 3. Press "Read more":
- 4. Select whether you want to reset the entire machine or a single profile, then press "Next";
- Follow the instructions, then confirm the reset by pressing "Ok".
- 6. Press "X" to go back to the homepage (C).

#### Please note:

When the appliance (not the individual profile) has been reset to the default values, the machine proposes the introductory tutorial again.


Steam will come out after each drink (fig. 15). This is part of normal use.



# 11.1 Prepare the machine to make coffee drinks *Important!*

Do not use green, caramelised or candied coffee beans as they could stick to the coffee grinder and make it unusable.

- 1. Place 1 or 2 cups under the coffee spouts (A13);
- Lower the spouts as near as possible to the cup (fig. 16).
   This makes a creamier coffee.



# 11.2 Directly selected drinks

1. Press the image on the homepage (C) corresponding to the coffee you want to make (C7) (e.g. eEpresso, fig. 17);



- Hot coffee drink: the appliance starts preparation.Cold coffee drinks:
  - Select to make an "Ice" or "Extra Ice" drink: press "Next";
  - Depending on the previous selection, before delivery, the appliance suggests the quantity of ice cubes. Add the quantity of ice cubes indicated to the glass (fig. 18), then press "Brew".



· The appliance starts preparation.

A description of each individual phase (grinding, brewing coffee) appears on the display.


At the end of preparation, the appliance is ready to make the next drink.

### 11.3 Customising the drinks

To make coffee drinks with customised parameters, proceed as follows:

 Press the customising settings (C6) at the bottom of the image corresponding to the coffee you want to make (e.g. espresso, fig. 19). The parameters that can be customised according to taste appear on the display:





 Hot coffee drink: After setting the parameters, press "Brew". The appliance starts making the drink and a description of each individual phase (grinding, brewing coffee) appears on the display;

**Cold coffee drinks:** Set the size, then press "Start" and proceed as follows:

- Select whether to make an "Ice" or "Extra Ice" drink, then press "Next";
- Depending on the previous selection, before delivery, the appliance suggests the quantity of ice cubes. Add the quantity of ice cubes indicated to the glass (fig. 16), then press "Brew".
- The appliance starts making the drink and a description of each individual phase (grinding, brewing coffee) appears on the display.
- At the end of delivery, press "Save" to save the new settings, or "Cancel" to retain the previous parameters. You can also save for the moment of the Coffee Routine.

#### Please note:

If you save the new settings, they are memorised ONLY in the selected profile.

The appliance is ready to be used again.

# 11.4 Making coffee using pre-ground coffee *Important!*

- Never add pre-ground coffee when the machine is off or it could spread through the inside of the machine and dirty it. This could damage the machine.
- Never use more than 1 level scoop (D2) as it could soil the inside of the coffee machine or block the funnel (A16).

When using pre-ground coffee, only one cup can be made at a time.

- Making Long coffee: halfway through preparation, when requested by the appliance, add one level measure of preground coffee and press "Ok".
- You cannot make 2x Espresso drinks using pre-ground coffee.
- Press the customising settings (C6) at the bottom of the image corresponding to the drink you want to make (e.g. espresso, fig. 19).
- 3. Choose the size and press "Brew".
- Lift the pre-ground coffee funnel lid (A17), make sure the funnel (A16) is not blocked, then add one level scoop (D2) of pre-ground coffee (fig. 20). Press "Ok" to make the drink;



The appliance starts making the drink and a description of each individual phase appears on the display.

At the end of preparation, the appliance is ready to make the next drink.

#### Proceed as follows:

- Press the customising settings (C6) at the bottom of the image corresponding to the drink you want to make (e.g. espresso, fig. 19).
- 2. Press "Extra Shot", then "Ok".
- Select the desired size and intensity. Press "Brew".
- 4. Confirm by pressing "Ok".
- The appliance starts making the drink and a description of each individual phase (grinding, brewing + extra grinding and brewing) appears on the display.
- At the end of delivery, press "Save" to save the new settings, or "Cancel" to retain the previous parameters. You can also save it for the moment in the Coffee Routine.

#### Please note:

If you save the new settings, they are memorised ONLY in the selected profile.

The appliance is ready to be used again.

### 11.6 General indications for making coffee drinks

- While the machine is making the coffee, preparation can be interrupted at any moment by pressing "Stop" or "Cancel".
- As soon as delivery has ended, to increase the quantity of coffee, just press "Extra". When the required quantity is reached, press "Stop" or "Cancel".
- Various alarm messages could be displayed while using the appliance ("Please fill the tank with fresh water up to MAX level" etc.). Their meaning is explained in section "22. Displayed messages".
- If the coffee is delivered a drop at a time, too weak and not creamy enough, or too cold, consult the"9.14 Grinder setting" tutorial included in the setting menu ((C5)) and section "23. Troubleshooting".
- If "Energy Saving" mode is activated, there may be a few seconds delay before the first coffee is delivered.

### 11.7 Tips for a hotter coffee

To make a hotter coffee, proceed as follows:

- perform a hot rinse cycle before making hot drinks (see "9.1 Rinsing"in the menu ((C5));
- warm the cups with hot water using the hot water function (select the relative picture and follow the instructions on the display);
- increase the coffee temperature ("9.10 Coffee temperature" in the menu (C).

#### 12. BEAN ADAPT TECHNOLOGY

A coffee expert at your fingertips to help you optimise coffee brewing and the result in your cup in just a few steps.

The smart technology guides you to adjust the machine according to the coffee beans used - from grinding coarseness to brewing, each phase will be regulated to get the best results from the coffee bean.

Download and open the Coffee Link mini program to find out more.

To make espresso coffee, follow the instructions in section "11.2 Directly selected drinks".

#### 13. COFFEE ROUTINE

If you enable the coffee routine, your machine will remember the settings you decide for each moment during the day.

- Press the coffee moment icon (C2) on the homepage;
- Enable the function activating the switch on the display Download and open the Coffee Link mini program to customise your routines of the working and rest days.

#### Please note:

To disable coffee routine, press the coffee moment icon and turn off the function.



To avoid milk with poor froth or large bubbles, always clean the milk carafes as described in sections "14.6 Cleaning the milk carafe after every use" and "19.11 Complete cleaning of the milk carafes (E)".

#### 14.2 Which milk to use?




# 14.3 Filling and attaching the milk carafe

- Lift the lid (E2) and fill the milk container (E5) with a sufficient quantity of milk, not exceeding the MAX level marked on the carafe (fig. 21);
- 2. Make sure the milk intake tube (E6) is correctly inserted on the bottom of the milk carafe lid (fig. 22);





- Put the lid back on the milk container;
- Slide down the lid and attach the carafe to the connector (A14), pushing as far as it will go (fig. 23). The machine emits a beep (if the function is enabled);



 Place a sufficiently large cup under the coffee spouts (A13) and milk spout (E3) (fig. 24). The milk spout of the "Hot" lattecrema can be lengthened by adjusting the extension (E4):

#### Please note:

If "Energy Saving" mode is enabled, you may have to wait a few seconds before the appliance makes the drink.

#### 14.4 Adjusting the froth

Turn the froth adjustment dial (E1) to adjust the froth delivered while making milk drinks.

# 14.5 Making milk drinks


On the homepage (C), press the image corresponding to the drink you want to make (C7).

As for coffee drinks, you can make a customised drink by pressing the drink customising symbol (C6) at the bottom of the image on the homepage.

# 14.6 Cleaning the milk carafe after every use

Each time you deliver a milk drink, the appliance asks you to perform the CLEAN function to clean the milk carafe lid (E2). To start cleaning, proceed as follows:

 Leave the milk carafe in the machine (you do not need to empty it);  Place a cup or other recipient under the milk spout (E3) (fig. 25);





- Turn the froth adjustment/clean dial (E1) to "Clean" (fig. 26). Hot water and steam are delivered from the milk spout. Cleaning stops automatically;
- 4. Turn the dial back to one of the froth selections:

#### If you want to make a number of drinks in succession:

 To proceed with making the next drinks, when the "Clean" message is displayed, press "Cancel". Clean the milk carafe after making the last drink.

# At the end of preparation, the milk carafe is empty, or there is not enough milk for other drinks

 After cleaning using the "Clean" function, extract the milk carafe and clean all the components as described in section "19.11 Complete cleaning of the milk carafes (E)"

### At the end of preparation, there is enough milk left in the carafe for other drinks

After cleaning using the "Clean" function, extract the milk carafe and place it immediately in the refrigerator. The "HOT" carafe can be kept in the refrigerator for no more than 2 days while the "COOL" carafe for no more than 1 day; then all the components should be cleaned as described in section "19.11 Complete cleaning of the milk carafes (E)".

#### Important:

If the milk carafe has been left out of the refrigerator for more than **30 minutes**, disassemble and clean all the components as described in section "19.11 Complete cleaning of the milk carafes (E)".

#### General notes after making milk drinks:

- If you do not clean the milk carafe, the symbol appears on the homepage to remind you that it needs cleaning.
- In certain cases, the appliance will need to warm up before the carafe can be cleaned.
- To ensure correct cleaning, wait for the Clean function to end. The function stops automatically. It must not be interrupted while underway.

#### 15. PREPARING HOT WATER.

- 1. Insert the hot water spout (D5) in the machine (fig. 5);
- 2. Place a cup under the hot water spout;
- 3. On the homepage (C):
- directly press the image corresponding to hot water (C7): delivery starts.
- choose the quantity by pressing the customising symbol (C6) at the base of the image, then press "Brew". Delivery starts.
- 4. Preparation begins and stops automatically.

#### Please note:

- To stop brewing, press "Stop" or "Cancel".
- As soon as delivery has ended, to increase the quantity of water, just press "Extra". When the required quantity is reached, press "Stop" or "Cancel".

### Proceed as follows:

- Press the customising settings (C6) at the bottom of the image corresponding to the coffee you want to make.
- 2. Press : you entered the "to go" function.
- 3. Press "Next" then "Ok".
- Pressing ( displays information on the quantities corresponding to the size of the travel mug;

- 5. Press (1) to select the size of your drink: press "Save".
- The new "to go" size is saved and next time will be automatically set. Press "X".
- Press "Brew": the machine proceed preparing the drink as usual.

#### Please note:

- Each time you use a mug different from the one used previously, we recommend you remain nearby to check the quantity of drink delivered.
- If you save the new settings, they are memorised ONLY in the selected profile.
- To maintain the temperature of hot drinks, preheat the travel mug with hot water.
- When choosing the travel mug to use, make sure it is no taller than 14 cm.

#### **Important**

- Before screwing on the lid, open the closing cap to release the pressure;
- At the end of preparation of milk drinks, clean the milk carafe (E) as iillustrated on paragraph "14.6 Cleaning the milk carafe after every use".
- You should use the contents within a maximum of 2 hours.
   After that time, empty and clean as described in the following section.
- For more information, see the leaflet attached to the travel muq.

# **16.1 Cleaning the De'Longhi travel mug after use** (sold separately)

For hygiene reasons, the travel mug should always be cleaned after use. Do not use abrasive materials that could damage the surface of the container.

#### Proceed as follows:

- 1. Unscrew the lid and rinse the container and lid with hot drinking water  $(40^{\circ}\text{C})$ .
- Soak the components in hot water (40°C) with washing up liquid for at least 30 minutes. Do not use scented detergents.
- Clean the inside of the container and the lid with a clean sponge and washing up liquid, removing any visible dirt.
- 4. Rinse all components with hot drinking water (40°C).
- Dry all components with a clean, dry cloth or paper towels, then reassemble.
- Wash the lid in the dishwasher once a week. The metal container is not dishwasher safe

#### 17. CHANGING BEAN HOPPER



Switch the bean hopper (D6) to enjoy a different coffee blend.

Proceed as follows:

- Rotate the bean hopper in "unlock" position (fig. 12) and leave it in this position until the procedure is finished;
- The display shows the "Switch mode" procedures: select one option and follow the steps:

# Choose a drink (Use the remaining beans to make a drink of your choice):

- Select "Choose a drink": the homepage shows the drinks you can make (the intensity is automatically selected and cannot be changed);
- 4. Proceed brewing the drink as usual;

# Grind & Empty (Run a grinding cycle to remove the remaining beans):

- Select "Grind & Empty": the machine grinds the remaining beans:
- Press "Start" and wait until the machine automatically stops;

#### Now you can insert the new bean hopper

- 5. Remove the bean hopper;
- Insert the new bean hopper in its housing and rotate it clockwise to lock it. For correct operation, align the unlock symbol to the mark on the ring (fig. 8) and, once inserted, rotate it to the lock position (fig. 9).

#### Please note:

If you directly change the bean hopper without emptying the grinder, the coffee brewed will be with a mix between the old and new blends.

#### Attention:

- It is normal to find coffee powder on the bean hopper's housing on the machine.
- If it is difficut to insert the new hopper, make sure there is no coffee beans on the hopper housing on the machine. In this case, clean the hopper's housing on the machine with the cleaning brush (D2) and a soft, damp cloth. To remove the coffee powder, use a hand vacuum cleaner.

# 18. "MY" FUNCTION ("Hot" drinks only) കി

With the "my function", you can customise the drink as follows:

- Make sure the profile (B4) whose drink you want to customise is active:
- Press drink customising (C6) at the bottom of the image corresponding to the drink you want to make (fig. 17);
- 3. Press (my);
- 4. Press "Start" and follow the guided procedure.

#### Please note:

- If you save the new settings, they are memorised ONLY in the selected profile.
- When you customise a single drink, the respective double version is also customised.

- Press "X" to exit programming at any moment. The values will not be saved.
- When a drink has been customised, "Reset" (on the right side) and "my" (close to "Brew") appear in the settings.
   Press "Reset" to reset the default values for the drink. Press "my" to switch to default settings.

#### 19. CLEANING SO

### 19.1 Cleaning the machine

The following parts of the machine must be cleaned regularly:

- the appliance's internal circuit;
- bean hopper (A1):
- coffee grounds container (A8);
- drip tray (A12) and drip tray grille (A11);
- water tank (A7);
- coffee spouts(A13);
- pre-ground coffee funnel (A16);
- brewing unit (A3), extractable after opening the brewing unit flapdoor (A4);
- milk carafes (E) (Hot and Cool).

#### Important!

- Do not use solvents, abrasive detergents or alcohol to clean the coffee machine. With De'Longhi superautomatic coffee machines, no chemical products are required for cleaning purposes.
- Do not use metal objects to remove encrustations or coffee deposits as they could scratch metal or plastic surfaces.

# 19.2 Cleaning the internal circuit

If the appliance is not used for more than 3 days, before using it again, we strongly recommend empty and fill the water tank with fresh potable water, switch it on and perform 2/3 rinse cycles by selecting the "Rinsing" function ("9.1 Rinsing").

#### Please note:

After cleaning, it is normal for the grounds container (A8) to contain water.

### 19.3 Cleaning the bean hoppers

Periodically clean the bean hopper (A1). Proceed as follows:

- Rotate counterclockwise the bean hopper to the "unlock" position (fig. 12) and leave it in this position until the procedure finishes: you enter the "Switch mode".
- 2. Select one option and follow the dedicated steps.
- 3. Then remove the bean hopper.
- 4. Remove the bean hopper lid. If the bean hopper is not empty, store the coffee beans in a container.
- Clean all visible residues both internally and externally by passing the hopper with a soft, damp cloth.
- Clean the hopper's housing on the machine with the cleaning brush (D2) and a soft, damp cloth. To remove the coffee powder, use a hand vacuum cleaner.
- Dry the bean hopper and its lid with a dry, clean cloth or paper and check the hopper is completely dry.
- 8. Fill the hopper with coffee beans, close it with its lid. Insert the bean hopper in its housing and rotate it clockwise to lock it. For correct operation, align the "unlock" symbol to the mark on the ring (fig. 8) and, once inserted, rotate it to the "lock" position (fig. 9)

# 19.4 Cleaning the coffee grounds container

When the machine requires it, the grounds container must be emptied and cleaned. The appliance cannot be used to make coffee until you have cleaned the grounds container (A8). Even if not full, the empty grounds container message is displayed 72 hours after the first coffee has been prepared. For the 72 hours to be calculated correctly, the machine must never be disconnected from the mains power supply.

#### Important! Danger of scalding

If you make a number of milk-based drinks one after the other, the metal cup tray (A10) becomes hot. Wait for it to cool down before touching it

To clean (with the machine on):

- 1. Remove the drip tray (A12) and grounds container (A8) (fig. 14).
- Empty the drip tray and grounds container and clean thoroughly to remove all residues left on the bottom.
- 3. Put the drip tray complete with grille (A11) and grounds container back in the appliance.

#### Important!

When removing the drip tray, the grounds container must be emptied, even if it contains only a few grounds. If this is not done, when you make the next coffees, the grounds container will fill up more than expected and cloq the machine.

# 19.5 Cleaning the drip tray and drip tray grille *Important!*

The drip tray (A12) is fitted with a level indicator (red) showing the amount of water it contains (fig. 27).



Before the indicator protrudes from the cup tray (A10), the drip tray must be emptied and cleaned, otherwise the water may overflow the edge and damage the appliance, the surface it rests on or the surrounding area. To remove the drip tray, proceed as follows:

- 1. Remove the drip tray with all the components;
- Remove and empty the drip tray and coffee grounds container (A8);
- Remove the cup tray (A10) and drip tray grille (A11) andwash all components;
- 4. Put the drip tray complete with all the components.


#### Important!

When removing the drip tray, the grounds container must be emptied, even if it contains few grounds. If this is not done, when you make the next coffees, the grounds container will fill up more than expected and clog the machine.

# 19.6 Cleaning the inside of the machine Danger of electric shock!

Before cleaning internal parts, the machine must be turned off (see section "7. Turning the appliance on") and unplugged from the mains power supply. Never immerse the machine in water.

- Check regularly (about once a month) that the inside of the appliance (accessible after removing the drip tray (A15)) is not dirty.
- 2. Remove all residues with a vacuum cleaner (fig. 28).



### 19.7 Cleaning the water tank

Clean the water tank (A7) periodically (about once a month) and whenever you replace the water softener filter (D4).


- Extract the water tank, remove the water softener filter (if present) and rinse with running water;
- Empty the water tank and clean it using hot water and a clean, non-abrasive cloth if necessary. Rinse thoroughly with water:
- 3. Put the filter back in the appliance, fill the tank with fresh water up to the MAX level and put the tank back;
- (models with water softener filter only) Deliver 100ml of hot water to reactivate the filter.

#### Please note:

If the appliance is not used for more than 3 days, you should clean the tank as described above.

### 19.8 Cleaning the coffee spouts

- Clean the coffee spouts (A13) regularly with a sponge or cloth (fig. 29):
- Check the holes in the coffee spouts are not blocked. If necessary, remove coffee deposits with a toothpick (fig. 30).



# 19.9 Cleaning the pre-ground coffee funnel

Clean the pre-ground coffee funnel (A16) regularly (about once a month) with a damp cloth. Proceed as follows:

- Turn the machine off (see chapter "8. Turning the appliance off";
- Open the accessories storage lid (A17);
- 3. Remove the coffee scoop/cleaning bruh (D2);
- 4. Extract the removable funnel.
- 5. Clean the funnel with the brush provided;
- 6. Reinsert the funnel in its housing;
- 7. Close the lid.

#### Important!

After cleaning, make sure there are no accessories left in the funnel. The presence of foreign objects in the funnel while the machine is in operation could damage the appliance.


#### 19.10 Cleaning the brewing unit

The brewing unit (A3) must be cleaned at least once a month.

#### Important!

The brewing unit cannot be extracted while the machine is on.

- Make sure the machine is correctly turned off (see section "8. Turning the appliance off");
- 2. Remove the water tank (A7);
- 3. Open the brewing unit door (A4) (fig. 31) on the right side of the appliance;



4. Press the two coloured release buttons inwards and at the same time pull the brewing unit outwards (fig. 32);

5. Soak the brewing unit in water for about 5 minutes, then rinse under the tap;

#### Important!


RINSF WITH WATER ONLY

NO DETERGENTS - NO DISHWASHER

- Do not use detergents when cleaning the brewing unit, as they could damage it.
- Use the cleaning brush (D2) to remove any coffee residues left in the brewing unit housing, visible through the brewing unit flap;
- After cleaning, replace the brewing unit by sliding it onto the internal support, then push the PUSH symbol fully in until it clicks into place;

#### Please note:

If the brewing unit is difficult to insert, before insertion, adapt it to the right size by pressing the two levers (fig. 33).




- Once inserted, make sure the two coloured buttons have snapped out;
- 10. Close the brewing unit door;
- 11. Put the water tank back.

# 19.11 Complete cleaning of the milk carafes (E)

Each week the appliance reminds you to clean the milk carafes thoroughly and proposes the correct cleaning sequence: this cleaning will grant optimal results through the time.

Proceed as follows:

Extract the milk carafe lid (E2));






2. Extract the milk spout (E3), milk spout extension (E4) ("Hot" carafe only) and milk intake tube (E6) (fig. 34);

- Turn the froth adjustment dial (E1) clockwise over the "Insert" position (fig. 35) and pull to extract;
- Turn counterclockwise and remove the milk carafe connector (E7) (fig. 36).





- Wash in a dishwasher (recommended) or by hand as indicated below:
- In a dishwasher: Rinse all the above components and the milk carafe with hot running drinking water (at least 40°C), then place them in the top basket of the dishwasher and run a programme at 50°C, e.g. standard ECO.
- By hand: Thoroughly rinse all the components and the
  milk carafe with hot running drinking water (at least 40°C)
  to remove all visible milk residues; make sure to run the
  water through the holes in the lid (fig. 37). Then immerse
  all the components in hot drinking water (at least 40°C) and
  washing up liquid for at least 30 minutes. Rinse all the above
  components thoroughly under hot drinking water, rubbing
  them one at a time with your hands.
- Make sure there are no milk residues on the hollow and groove under the dial (fig. 38). If necessary, scrape the groove with a toothpick;



- Check that the intake tube and spout are not clogged with milk residues:
- 8. Dry all the components with a clean dry cloth;
- 9. Reassemble all the lid components:
- 10. Attach the lid back on the milk carafe.

#### Please note:

Each week the appliance reminds you to clean the milk carafe thoroughly and proposes the correct cleaning sequence again.

### 20. DESCALING.

#### Important!

- Before use, read the instructions and labelling on the descaler pack.
- Use De'Longhi descaler only. Using unsuitable descaler and/or performing descaling incorrectly may result in faults not covered by the manufacturer's quarantee.
- Descaler could damage delicate surfaces. If the product is accidentally spilt, dry immediately.




Descale the appliance when the corresponding message appears on the homepage. To descale immediately, press "Ok" and follow the step by step instructions on the display.

To descale the appliance later, press "Cancel". The (C4) appears on the homepage to remind you the appliance needs descaling. (The message appears each time you turn the appliance on).

To access the descaling menu:

- 1. Press the settings menu icon (C5) on the homepage;
- Scroll through the menu items until "Descaling" is displayed;
- 3. Press "Start" to enter the guided descaling procedure;
- 4. Press "Yes" to begin;
- Insert the water spout (D5) (fig. 5) (it is stored in the accessories compartament on top of the machine);
- Remove and empty the drip tray (A12) and coffee grounds container (A8) (fig. 14), then put both back in the appliance and press "Next";
- Remove the water tank (A7), lift the lid (A6) and (if inserted) remove the filter (D4). Empty the tank completely.
- Pour the descaler into the tank up to the level A marked inside the tank (equal to one 100ml pack), then add water (one litre) up to level B (fig. 39). Put the water tank (with lid) back in the appliance and press "Start";





Place an empty 1,5 I container under the spouts (fig. 40).
 Press "Done": desing starts ("Back" to go back to the previous screen or "X" to exit the procedure, remembering to remove the descaling solution from the tank)

# Important! Danger of scalding

Hot water containing acid flows out of the spouts. Take care to avoid contact with splashes of this solution.

10. The descale programme starts and the descaler liquid comes out of the hot water and coffee spouts. A series of rinses is performed automatically to remove all the scale residues inside the coffee machine:

After about 20 minutes, the descaling action ceases:

11. The appliance is now ready to be rinsed through with clean water. Empty the container used to collect the descaler solution. Remove the water tank, empty, rinse under running water, fill with fresh potable water up to the MAX level and put back in the appliance (fig. 41). Press "Next";



- 12. Place the container used to collect the descaler solution empty under the spouts and press "Yes" to start rinsing;
- 13. Hot water is delivered from both the hot water spout and coffee spouts;
- 14. When the water in the tank has run out, empty the container used to collect the rinsing water;
- 15. Extract the water tank and put back the water softener filter if removed previously.

- Fill the tank with fresh water up to the MAX level, put back in the appliance and press "Next" to continue.
- Place the container used to collect the descaler solution empty under the spouts and press "Next" to start another rinsing cycle;
- 18. When the water in the tank has run out, empty the container used to collect the rinsing water, remove and empty the drip tray (A15) and grounds container (A10), then put back in the appliance. Press "Next".
- 19. The descaling process is now complete". Press "OK".
- 20. Extract the water tank, top up to the max level and put it back in the machine
- 21. The appliance performs a rapid preheat cycle and then goes back to the homepage.

#### Please note:

- If the descaling cycle is not completed correctly (e.g. electrical power failure) the appliance will request to complete it next time you switch it on;
- After descaling, it is normal for the grounds container (A8) to contain water.
- If the water tank has not been filled to the MAX level after descaling, the appliance prompts for a third rinse to ensure that the descaler solution has been completely eliminated from the machine's internal circuits. Before starting rinsing, remember to empty the drip tray.


#### 21. WATER SOFTENER FILTER

Certain models are fitted with a water softener filter (D4). If this is not the case with your model, you are recommended to purchase one from De'Longhi Customer Services.

To use the filter correctly, follow the instructions below.

# 21.1 Installing the filter

- 1. Press the settings menu (C5);
- 2. Scroll through the pages and select "Water filter";
- 3. Press "Yes" to enter the guided procedure
- 4. Remove the filter from the packaging and turn the date indicator to view the next 2 months (fig. 42);






#### Please note:

The filter lasts about two months if the appliance is used normally. If the machine is left unused with the filter installed, it will last a maximum of 3 weeks.

- Press "Next" to continue ("Back" to go back to the previous screen; "X" to cancel the operation);
- To activate the filter, run potable water through the hole in the centre of the filter until water comes out of the openings at the side for more than a minute (fig. 43). Press "Next";
- Extract the water tank (A7) (fig. 2) and fill with potable water; insert the filter in the water tank and immerse the bottom pressing the center of the filtre 2 or 3 times to enable the air bubbles to escape (fig. 44). Press "Next";





- 8. Insert the filter in the filter housing (fig. 45) and push it down firmly. Close the tank with its lid (A6) and; press "Next";
- 9. Insert the hot water spout (D5). Press "Next";
- Position an empty container with a minimum capacity of 0.5 litres under the hot water spout (fig. 6) and press "Yes" to activate the filter;
- 11. The appliance delivers hot water, then stops automatically. Press "OK" to go back to the homepage;
- 12. The filter is now active and you can use the coffee machine.

# 21.2 Replacing or removing the filter

Replace the filter (D4) when the replace filter message appears on the homepage (C). To replace the filter immediately, press "OK" and follow the instructions from point 3 of the previous section. To replace the filter later, press "Cancel". The filter symbol appears on the display to remind you the filter needs replacing.

To replace, proceed as follows:

- 1. Press the settings menu (C5);
- Scroll through the pages until "Water filter" is displayed, then press "Read More";
- Press "Yes" to enter the guided procedure;
- Extract the water tank (A7) and exhausted filter.
- 5. To remove the filter, press "OK" ("Back" to go back to the previous screen; "X" to cancel the operation);
- 6. To replace the filter, press "Next" and follow the operations described in the previous section from point (4).

# Please note:

After two months (see date indicator) or when the appliance has not been used for 3 weeks, you should replace the filter even if the message has not yet been displayed.
