
























ABOUT THIS MANUAL

Even if the appliances are made in conformity with the European regulatory specifications in force and therefore all potentially hazardous parts are protected. Carefully read these warnings and use the appliance only for the use it is designed for in order to prevent accidents and damage. Keep this manual close by for future consultation. Should you decide to give this appliance to other people, remember to also include these instructions.

INTENDED USE

The appliance is suitable for thoroughly cleaning and sanitizing floors, as marble, ceramic, stone, tiles, parquet, as well as hard-wood floors provided they are treated and impervious. Use the cloth to absorb excessive moisture. The appliance exploits active power of steam without the need of detergents and soaps.

Any other use of the appliance is not intended by the Manufacturer who does not accept any responsibility for damages of any kind caused by improper use of the appliance itself. Improper use also results in voiding of any form of warranty.

RESIDUAL RISKS



Warning!

Do not use the device on surfaces treated with wax. The wax will be removed by the action of heat and steam. Do not use on permeable floors on untreated wood. Do not leave the appliance on any kind of wooden surface for a prolonged period of time: wood might swell.

It is advisable to try the appliance on a hidden area of the domestic floor first. Otherwise, it is advisable to ask for information to the floor manufacturer about the cleaning modes.

SAFETY WARNINGS

READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USE.

- This appliance is intended for household use and similar.
- We decline any responsibility resulting from misuse or any use other than those covered in this booklet.
- We suggest you keep the original box and packaging, as our free-of-charge service does not cover any damage resulting from inadequate packaging of the product when this is sent back to an Authorised Service Centre.
- The use of attachments that are not recommended or not supplied by the appliance manufacturer might cause the risk of fire, electric shock or injury.



- This appliance cannot be used by people with reduced physical, sensorial or mental capabilities, with no experience and knowledge unless supervised or trained beforehand about safe use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Make sure children do not play with the appliance.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children when it is powered or in cooling-down phase.
- Do not leave the packaging parts near children since they are potentially dangerous.
- Prevent children from dropping the appliance by holding the power cord.
- In the event that this appliance is to be disposed of, it is advisable to cut the power chord off to make it out of use. Those parts of the appliance that could be dangerous should be rendered armless, especially for children who might use the appliance as a toy.

Warning of burns

- Do not touch the metal parts of the appliance, hot water or steam when it is in operation and for several minutes after it is turned off to prevent the risk of burns.
 - Do not direct the jet of steam towards parts of the body, pets, plants or delicate objects.

 • Do not leave the appliance on the ground when in operation or im
 - mediately after it is turned off. Always use the attachment for carpet cleaning for leaning the appliance.
 - · Never direct the jet of steam towards appliances containing electrical parts (e.g. inside ovens).
- Before removing the cloth from the steam head, disconnect the power cord from the mains socket. Wait at least 5 minutes to allow both the steam head and the cloth to cool down.

⚠ Danger due to electricity

- Before plugging the appliance into the mains socket, ensure that the voltage shown on the rating plate matches the local voltage supply.
- The use of extension leads not authorised by the appliance manufacturer may cause damage and accidents.
- Always connect the appliance to an earthed socket.
- Never immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Do not use the appliance if your hands are wet or if you are barefoot.
- Do not use the appliance if the power cord or the plug are damaged, or if the appliance is faulty. To prevent any accident, all repairs, including the replacement

of the power cord, must be carried out by an Authorised Service Centre or by qualified personnel.

- Do not connect any other high-power appliance (stoves, irons, radiators, etc.) to the same socket. Burn hazard.
- Do not put the hot parts of the appliance on the power cord.
- Do not disconnect the appliance by pulling the power cord.
- Do not leave the power cord against sharp edges or parts.
- Make sure the power cord does not come in contact with hot surfaces. Do not move the appliance by pulling the power cord.
- In case of thunderstorm, disconnect the power cord from the mains socket.
- Unplug the appliance after use and before carrying out cleaning and maintenance operations.

🖎 Warning – material damage

- Do not use the appliance for cleaning raw wooden/non-impermeable floors, soft plastic, wooden objects, and leather.
- Do not use the appliance on glass surfaces.
- Do not use the appliance with the worn cloth. Risk of damage and scratches on the floor.
- Always unwind the power cord before use.
- To avoid damage to the pump, do not use the appliance with no water. Regularly check the water level in the tank.
- Do not use sparkling (carbonated) water. Do not use sparkling (carbonated) water. In case of particularly hard water (hardness above 20°f), use a mix composed by 50% tap water and 50% purified water.
- The appliance must only be cleaned with a soft, slightly damped, cloth after having unplugged the appliance and allowed all its parts to cool down. Never use solvents that may damage the plastic parts.
- Do not pour descalers or other scented substances into the tank; otherwise, the warranty would be no longer valid.
- Always unplug the appliance before storing it. Wait for it to cool down and completely empty the tank.
- Do not expose the appliance to atmospheric agents (rain, sun, etc.).
- Any changes to this product not expressly authorized by the manufacturer may make void safety and warranty of the operator's use.
- The appliance is not to be used if it has been dropped, if there are visible sign of damage or if it is leaking.

- Do not use the appliance in the presence of vapours given off by oil-based paints, solvents or waterproofing agents, by flammable power or other toxic or explosive vapours.
- Be very careful when using the appliance with a ladder.
- Fill up the tank with water before starting up the appliance. Before carrying out the filling operations with water, unplug the appliance.
- Turn on the appliance only when it is in working position.
- Never leave the appliance unattended when it is connected to the power supply.
- Before leaving the appliance unattended for few minutes, always place it on the attachment for carpet cleaning. Turn the appliance off and always disconnect the power cord from the main socket.

APPLIANCE ASSEMBLY

After unpacking the appliance, proceed as follows:

Insert the grip (A) in the motor unit (G), by pressing it slightly downwards until it locks in place (Fig. 2).



Warning!

Before use, make sure the appliance is assembled properly.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Totally unwind the power cord by releasing it from apposite cord winder hooks (B). Open the filling compartment (E), Fig. 3, and fill the tank (F) up to the MAX mark using the supplied measuring cup (O) - Fig. 4. Close the filling compartment (E) back without forcing.



Warning!

NEVER fill the tank beyond the MAX level. In case of particularly hard water (hardness above 20°f), use a mix composed by 50% tap water and 50% purified water



Warning!

Make sure the tank is filled enough to avoid dry running.

To protect the floor from high temperatures, it is advisable to allow the appliance to warm up/cool down on the carpet cleaning attachment.

Before use, make sure objects and surfaces to be treated are resistant or compatible with the high temperature of steam. In case of treated terracotta floors and wooden surfaces, refer to the manufacturer's instructions and test the appliance first on a concealed area of the floor or a sample.

If the appliance is left standing on the floor whilst in use, a whitish ring may form. Not to worry, as this can be removed with a normal decalcification agent or with some drops of vinegar.

Place the cloth (N) under the steam head (I) with the protrusion of fabric backwards. Put the steam head (I) on the cloth (N) so that the latter adheres to the apposite Velcro situated at the bottom of the steam head (I) (Fig. 5).

Insert the plug into the socket, which must be earthed. The light integrated in the on/off button will turn on for 1 second (D).

Press the on/off button (D); the integrated indicator light will turn on, signalling the appliance is on and the internal boiler is starting to heat up. Furthermore, also the lights (L) situated at the front of the steam head (I) will go on.

After about 15 seconds, the device is ready for use.

Make sure there is no more dust on the floor.

Using the grip (A) and holding the steam head (I) with a foot, lower the handle (C) (Fig. 6); the appliance will start emitting steam. Clean the floor with a backward and forward movement.

After use, bring the handle (C) back to upright position to stop steam dispensing; press the on/off button (D) and disconnect the plug from the electric socket.



Warning!

Do not use the steam function without the cloth. The cloth can be purchased at Authorised Service Centres.

Use the appliance in well-lit rooms.



Warning!

Burn hazard! Do not turn the steam head upside-down during use to remove the cloth.

Unplug the appliance. Wait at least 5 minutes to allow both the steam head and the cloth to cool down.

To clean the stubborn dirt on the floor, it is possible to use also the front steam in addition. After having turned the appliance on and having waited the heating time of the boiler, press the rear lever (H) for dispensing steam with the foot (Fig. 7); steam will be dispensed from the apposite front hole (M) situated on the steam head (I).

After few seconds, release the lever (H), lower the handle (C) and clean the floor with a backward and forward movement.

Filling the tank during use

When the water tank is empty, the appliance will stop producing steam. No particular operation is required when there is not more water in the tank. After having disconnected the appliance, just open the compartment (E) and fill the tank (F) again with natural, fresh water. In case of particularly hard water (hardness above 20°f), use a mix composed by 50% tap water and 50% purified water.

Use of the attachment for carpet cleaning

This attachment must be used only to clean carpets and similar soft surfaces. Do not use the on hard surfaces.

Lay the carpet attachment (P) on the floor on the flat side. Make sure the cloth (N) is positioned underneath the steam head (I). Position the appliance on the attachment (P) by slightly pressing (Fig. 8). The appliance is ready for use.

After use

Disconnect the power cord from the mains socket. Empty the water tank completely by overturning the appliance to prevent the water from stagnating, which may form lime deposit.



Warning!

Wait at least 5 minutes to allow both the steam head and the cloth to cool down.

Remove the cloth to rinse it by positioning a foot on the relevant protrusion and lifting the appliance (Fig. 9). Wrap the power cord on the hooks (B) - Fig. 10. Position the appliance on the attachment for carpet cleaning (P). Position the motor body vertically.



To put the appliance stably in vertical position, engage the joint between the steam head and the motor unit.


Keep the appliance in a dry place out of reach of children.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE



Before cleaning, always disconnect the plug from the socket. Leave the appliance to cool down for a few minutes.





Warning!

Check the state of the power cable of your appliance on a regular basis before using it, and if it is damaged, take it to the service centre closest to you to have it replaced only by specialised personnel.

Do not use abrasives for cleaning the appliance.

Do not put vinegar, decalcifying products or other scented substances in the tank. Otherwise, the warranty would be no longer valid.

Appliance cleaning

Clean plastic parts with a damp, non-abrasive cloth and dry them with a dry cloth. Clean the water tank from time to time by putting fresh water in it. Rinse and empty. For cleaning washable cloths, refer to instructions on the labels.

Cleaning the limestone

Damage caused by limestone is not covered by warranty.

A good maintenance and regular cleaning preserve and keep the appliance effective for a longer period by significantly limiting the risks of formation of limestone deposits. If, despite this, after some time the appliance function should be compromised by the frequent use of hard/very calcareous water, proceed with descaling to eliminate malfunctioning.

Carry out cleaning once every three months. If water used is very hard and calcareous, carry out cleaning monthly.



Warning!

Do not leave the appliance unattended while operating.

Carry out cleaning of limestone in a ventilated area. During limestone cleaning, dispense steam on a resistant surface or a washable cloth. Do not breathe vapours produced during limestone cleaning.

- 1 Fill the tank with a mix of 1/3 of white vinegar and 2/3 of fresh, clean water.
- 2 Place the appliance so that the steam is not dispensed on any object or surface.
- 3 Plug in appliance. Lower the handle (C) and leave the appliance in operation for at least one minute. Lift the handle (C) and leave the appliance off for at least one minute. Repeat the procedure until steam is dispensed. Dispense steam completely until there is no more solution in the tank. Repeat the procedure, if necessary.
- 4 Disconnect plug from socket. Fill the tank with fresh, clean water. Rinse and empty.
- 5 Fill the tank with fresh, natural water.
- 6 Plug in appliance. Lower the handle (C) and dispense steam completely until there is no more water in the tank. Repeat the procedure, if necessary until there are no more limestone residues in the steam pipes.

To remove the limestone traces from the attachments, immerse them in a solution of water and vinegar. Fit the attachment onto the appliance and dispense steam.

TROUBLESHOOTING



Warning!

In case of malfunctioning and electrical faults, switch the appliance off immediately. Disconnect plug from socket. Wait for the appliance to cool down.

组装电器

从包装箱中取出电器,然后请按以下步骤操作:

将手柄(A)插入电机组件(G), 轻轻的向下按压直到锁住(图2)



警告!

体 使用之前,确保电器组装正确。

使用说明

从电源线收理架上(B)上解开电源线,打开加水口(E),图3,用提供的量杯(0)向水 槽内(F)加水加到最大水位-图4,轻轻的关闭加水口。



、向水槽内加水不要超过最大水位。如果水质特硬(硬度超过20°f),请使用纯净 水。



警告!

确保水箱的水充足,以免干烧。

为了保护地板不受高温的影响,建议电器在地毯清洁附件上加热/冷却。

使用之前,确保要处理的物体和表面耐高温或与高温蒸汽相融。如果是经过处理的 赤陶地板和木质表面,请参考制造商的说明,首先在地板隐蔽区或样品上测试机 器。

如果使用中将电器放置在地板上,可能会形成一个白环,不用担心,可以用普通的 脱钙剂或几滴醋即可清除。

将清洁布(N)放置在蒸汽喷头(I)上,将拖布的突出部分向后。用蒸汽喷头(I)压住 清洁布(N),使清洁布吸附在蒸汽喷头底部尼龙塔扣合适的位置上。(图5)

一定将插头插入接地插座, 开关按钮上的灯将开启1秒钟(D)。

按压开关按钮(D),开关指示灯打开,表示电器开启,内部锅炉开始加热。而且,位于 蒸汽喷头前面的灯(L)也会亮起,大约15秒钟后,设备就可以使用了。 确保地板上不再有灰尘。

握住手柄(A),用脚踩住蒸汽喷头(I),调整把手(C)(图6)角度:电器开始喷出

蒸汽, 前后移动电器来清洁地板。

使用后, 将把手(C) 调整回垂直的位置可停止蒸汽分发。按压开关按钮(D), 从电源插 座上拔掉插头,结束使用。

警告!

没有清洁布不可使用蒸汽功能。可以从授权服务中心购买清洁布,在光线充足的房 间使用本电器。

藝告!

烫伤风险! 使用中请勿将蒸汽喷头倒置来移除清洁布。

拔掉电器插头,至少等待5分钟让蒸汽喷头和清洁布冷却下来。

清除地板上的顽固污渍,还可以使用蒸汽喷头前端的蒸汽。开启电器后需要等待锅炉的加 热时间,用脚按压后面的杆(H)喷出蒸汽(图7),蒸汽会从蒸汽喷头前面的孔里喷出。 几秒钟后,松开蒸汽分发杆(H),降低把手(C),前后移动拖把来清洁地面。

使用中向水箱加水的方法

当水槽是空的,电器会停止产生蒸汽。当水槽没水时不需要特殊操作,拔掉电器插头,打 开加水口(E),向水槽内(F)加入纯净水。

使用地毯清洁附件的方法

此附件只能用于清洁地毯或类似的柔软表面,切勿在坚硬的表面使用。

将地毯附件(P)放置在平坦的地板上,确保清洁布(N)粘贴在蒸汽喷头下面,将附件 (P) 安装在蒸汽喷头上, 轻轻按压即可, 电器可以使用了。

使用后

从主插座上拔下电源线,将电器翻过来,将水箱的水全部排空,防止水淤塞,形成石灰沉 淀。



警告!

至少等待5分钟让蒸汽喷头及清洁布都冷却下来。

用脚压住清洁布突起的部分,提起机器,移除清洁布,冲洗干净(图9)。 把电源线缠绕在收理架上(B)图10. 将设备放置在地毯清洁附件(P)上,将电器垂直放 置



警告!

要使设备稳定的垂直放置,必须使蒸汽喷头和电机组件连接牢固。

请将电器放置在一个干燥儿童接触不到的地方。

清洁与维护



、在清洁电器之前,一定要从插座上拔下插头,让电器冷却几分钟。

每三个月定期清理一次。如果用水硬度较高,请每个月清理一次。

清除附件的石灰痕迹, 将附件浸泡在水和醋的溶液里, 将附件安装在电器上, 并喷出蒸 汽。
