

INTENDED USE

The appliance must be used to let melted chocolate and similar liquids flow on the tower's surfaces, creating a fountain-like effect. During operation it is possibile to dip various foods in the liquid (eg fruit, cookies, etc).

The appliance has been designed for home use only and must not be used for commercial or industrial purposes.

This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications as:

- Staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments
- Farm houses
- By clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments
- Bed and breakfast type environments

Any other use of the appliance is not intended by the Manufacturer who does not

Improper use also results in any form of warranty being forfeited.

RESIDUAL RISKS



RISK OF BURNS. By the nature of the product, hot surfaces are exposed during and after use. The covers on the item cannot prevent all risk of injury.

- 1. Using the item outside of its intended function or other misuse may result in injury, for which the manufacturer cannot be held liable.
- 2. We suggest you keep the original box and packaging, as our free-ofcharge service does not cover any damage resulting from inadequate packaging of the product when this is sent back to an Authorised Service Centre.
- 3. This appliance can be used by persons with reduced physical sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- 4. Do not affect the safety of the appliance by using parts that are not original or which have not been approved by the manufacturer

- 5. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years if the have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

- 7. Cleaning and maintenance by the user must not be carried out by children unless they are older than 8 years and are monitored during the operation.

- 10. Make sure that the voltage on the appliance rating plate corresponds to that of your local mains electricity supply.
- 11. Always connect the appliance to an earthed socket.
- 12. Never touch the appliance, the plug and the power cable with wet hands.
- 13. Never leave the appliance unattended when connected to the power supply; unplug it after every use.
- 14. Make sure that the power cord does not come into contact with hot or sharp surfaces.
- 15. The supply cable is intentionally short. This is a high power device and the use of extension leads is not recommended. Using an extension lead may introduce additional hazards to the environment for the user and those around them. Poor use of extensions leads can cause fires.
- 16. Remove the plug from the power outlet before cleaning or maintenance.
- 17. Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- 18. The appliance must not be used if it has been dropped, if there are visible signs of damage or leaks of water. Do not use the appliance if the power cord or the plug are damaged, or if the appliance is faulty. To prevent any accident, all repairs, including the replacement of the power cord, must be carried out by an Authorised Service Centre or, in any case, by qualified personnel

19. Do not touch the metal parts of the appliance when in operation and for several minutes after it is turned off since it could cause burns. The temperature of accessible surfaces may be high when the appliance is operating.

Danger of damage originating from other causes

- 20. Never leave the appliance unattended when it is connected to the power supply.
- 21. Turn on the appliance only when it is in working position.
- 22. Choose an adequately illuminated and clean room with easily accessible power outlet.
- 23. During use, rest the appliance onto a horizontal surface.
- 24. The appliance must be used and left at rest on a stable surface.



Danger of material damage

- 25. Place the appliance on a work surface that bears a temperature of at least 90°C (194°F). Do not place the appliance on delicate surfaces.
- 26. Use the appliance well away from flammable liquids. Do not use the appliance up against walls or close to parts in plastic that do not resist heat.
- 27. When the appliance is hot, do not rest it onto the power cord. Take special care in ensuring that the cord do not come into contact with the plates when it is hot.
- 28. Do not pull the power cord to unplug the appliance.
- 29. Do not expose the appliance to atmospheric agents (rain, sun ...).
- 30. External timers or separate remote controls to operate the appliance are not permitted.

Instructions for use



BEFORE USE

Assembling

- Wash and dry the appliance. Follow the instructions present in the "Cleaning and Maintenance" section.
- Mount the conveyor (D) on the rotating pin (G).
- Insert the support (E) in the lower part of the tower (F).
- Position the tower over the conveyor until the support (E) is inserted into the guide pins (C).

Pre-heating

Before using the appliance, it is necessary to do the preheating:

- Insert the plug into the socket, which must be earthed.
- Rotate the ON/OFF knob to position "I". The operation light (H) turns on.
- After 15-20 minutes the appliance is properly pre-heated.

INSTRUCTION FOR USE



Use already melted chocolate (or similar liquids). The appliance must not be used to melt solid chocolate. Don't pour in the cup differents food from the the ones indicated in the "Instructions for use".



Never touch the conveyor when it is moving.

- Pour the melted chocolate into the cup (B). If the chocolate is too dense, add a tablespoon of vegetal oil. The cup can contain about 350 grams of melted chocolate.
- Rotate the ON/OFF knob to position "II". The conveyor (D) starts rotating. The chocolate is conveyed to the top and flows down along the tower.
- You can dip fruit, cookies and other foods in the melted chocolate, using a wooden skewer or a similar object. Use a spoon to remove potential remains of solid foods, that can hinder the functioning of the conveyor.

AFTER USE

- Rotate the ON/OFF knob to position "0".
- Remove the remaining chocolate. If you want to reuse the remaining chocolate, put it in a container when it is still liquid.
- Wash the appliance after use. Follow the instructions present in the "Cleaning and maintenance" section.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE



RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK. Never immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.



Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool before cleaning.

NOTE

RISK OF MATERIAL DAMAGE. Check the state of the power cable before each use, and if it is damaged, take it to the service centre closest to you to have it replaced only by specialised personnel.

Cleaning the base

Clean plastic parts with a damp, non-abrasive cloth and dry them with a dry cloth.

NOTE

RISK OF MATERIAL DAMAGE. Don't immerse the base in water. Dont' wash in the dishwasher. Don't use aggressive products or solvents that may damage the plastic.

Cleaning of removable elements

 Disassemble and wash individually the tower, the conveyor and the tower holder. Use only warm water and non-aggressive products. Don't use abrasive sponges.

The removable elements can be washed in the dishwasher.
