- B Fondue Pot with non-stick coating
- C 2 x pot holders for dipping station
- D 6 x dipping pots
- E Removable temperature probe with power cord
- F Safety splatter ring

Risk of material damage

The appliance must be used to prepare fondue. The appliance has been designed for home use only and must not be used for commercial or industrial purposes.

Any other use of the appliance is not intended by the Manufacturer who does not accept any responsibility for damages of any kind caused by improper use of the appliance itself.

Improper use also results in any form of warranty being forfeited.

#### **RESIDUAL RISKS**



RISK OF BURNS. The constructive characteristics of the appliance, covered by this publication, do not allow to protect the user from possible contact with the hot surface of the fondue pot both during the intended use and in the minutes following its switching off.

#### ALWAYS KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS.

- 1. We decline any responsibility resulting from misuse or any use other than those covered in this booklet.
- 2. We suggest you keep the original box and packaging, as our free-of-charge service does not cover any damage resulting from inadequate packaging of the product when this is sent back to an Authorised Service Centre.
- 3. The appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:
  - > staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
  - > farm houses;
  - > by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
  - > bed and breakfast type environments.



## Danger for children

- 4. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack experience or knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
- 5. Do not leave the packaging near children because it is potentially dangerous.
- 6. Children shall not play with the appliance or its components.

7. Cleaning and maintenance by the user must not be carried out by children unless they are older than 8 years and are monitored during the operation.

8. Always keep the appliance, removabile temperature probe and the power cord out of the reach of children under the age of 8 years.



### Danger of electric shock

- 9. Make sure that the voltage on the appliance rating plate corresponds to that of your local mains electricity supply.
- 10. Always connect the appliance to an earthed socket.
- 11. Do not connect the removable temperature probe to the appliance if your hands are wet or if you are barefoot.
- 12. Never leave the appliance unattended when connected to the power supply; unplug it after every use.
- 13. Make sure that the power cord does not come into contact with hot or sharp surfaces.
- 14. It is not recommended to use this appliance in conjunction with an extension cord.
- 15. Remove the plug from the power outlet before cleaning or maintenance.
- 16. Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.



#### Danger of burns

- 17. Do not touch the metal parts of the appliance when in operation and for several minutes after it is turned off since it could cause burns.
- 18. All cleaning operations must be performed when the hot parts have cooled.



19. The fondue pot gets very hot during use. Avoid contact with metal parts as there is a danger of burns. The appliance must always be positioned on a stable, level, heat resistant surface during use. Use the handles to lift the fondue pot.





## Danger of damage originating from other causes

- 20. Never leave the appliance unattended when it is connected to the power supply.
- 21. Turn on the appliance only when it is in working position.
- 22. Choose an adequately illuminated and clean room with easily accessible power outlet.
- 23. During use, rest the appliance onto a horizontal surface.
- 24. The appliance must be used and left at rest on a stable surface.
- 25. Do not use this unit on or near a heat source such as a hob or naked flame.
- 26. The appliance is not to be used if it has been dropped, if there are visible sign of damage. Do not use the appliance if the power cord or the plug are damaged, or if the appliance is faulty. To prevent any accident, all repairs, including the replacement of the power cord, must be carried out by an Authorised Service Centre or by suitably qualified personnel.



## Danger of material damage

- 27. Place the appliance on a work surface that bears a temperature of at least 90°C (194°F). Do not place the appliance on delicate surfaces.
- 28. When the appliance is hot, do not rest it onto the power cord. Take special care in ensuring that the cable and the cord do not come into contact with the hot surface.
- 29. Do not pull the power cord to unplug the appliance. Do not pull the power cord to remove the temperature probe from the appliance.
- 30. Do not expose the appliance to atmospheric agents (rain, sun ...).
- 31. Do not use the appliance outdoors.
- 32. The appliance must not be power supplied by external timers or separate remote-controlled systems.


33. To avoid the risk of fire do not position the fondue pot under hanging kitchen cabinets as the unit releases heat. Also make sure that the appliance has sufficient space around it and does not come into contact with flammable materials.

- 34. Only use the supplied removable temperature control probe, no other types of temperature control probe should be used in any circumstances.
- 35. Only use accessories recommended by the supplier. The use of other accessories may result in damage to the appliance and will invalidate the guarantee.
- 36. Do not move the appliance whilst it is switched on or is still hot once cooking has ended. Turn off the appliance and wait until the fondue pot has cooled down completely before moving and cleaning it.
- 37. Repairs may only be carried out by a qualified electrician. Never attempt to repair the appliance yourself as this could lead to an electrical hazard and invalidate the guarantee.

Instructions for use



#### BEFORE USE



Risk of material damage. Do not place the appliance or power cord close to or on top of hot electric or gas cookers, or close to a microwave oven.

Prevent the cord from protruding beyond the edge of the table or surface. Prevent children from grabbing the cord, in this way tipping over the appliance.

Do not place the appliance near surfaces, materials or containers of flammable substances.

When using the appliance for the first time, it may happen that give off a slight odour and a bit of smoke. This is normal.

- Wash the accessories with hot water and detergent. Dry thoroughly with a soft cloth.
- Clean the fondue pot with a damp cloth and then dry it.

#### **Pre-heating**

Before using the appliance it is necessary to make the warm-up.


- Insert the removable temperature control probe securely into the connection socket (Fig. 5).
- Set the dial on the probe to MIN.
- Insert the plug into the outlet.
- Use the dial on the probe to change the temperature from MIN to MAX.


Heat the unit on the MAX setting for 5 minutes prior to first use, this will burn off any manufacturing dust and oil from the heating elements.



Risk of burns. Danger of contact with hot surfaces. The fondue pot and safety splatter ring can become very hot. Do not touch hot surfaces with bare hands. Use oven mitts.









Instructions for use



#### Assembling

- Place the unit on a stable, level, heat resistant surface where it can easily be plugged into an electrical socket (Fig. 2).
- Use handles to move the fondue pot.



Do not move the fondue pot after installing the pot holders. The handles are not accessible.

- Attach the pot holders to the front and back of the unit and secure by turning the small dial underneath (Fig. 3).
- Insert the small pots into the recesses (Fig. 4).

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- To prepare fondue, fill the fondue pot (B) with cheese. Respect the MAX limit indicated. **Do not fill the fondue pot above the max fill mark.**
- Insert the removable temperature control probe securely into the connection socket (Fig. 5). Insert the plug into mains socket and switch on.
- Use the dial on the probe to change the temperature from MIN to MAX.

The thermostat regulates a constant temperature. The thermostat indicator light will click on and off during use. This is normal and is just the temperature being constantly adjusted to maintain the desired warming temperature.

# **A** DANGER

Risk of burns. Danger of contact with hot surfaces. The fondue pot and the safety splatter ring can become very hot. Do not touch hot surfaces with bare hands. Use oven mitts.

- Place the safety splatter ring (F) on the fondue pot (B) (Fig. 6).
- Insert the forks into the recesses around the ring (Fig. 7).
- Add dipping ingredients into the small pots around the unit.









#### CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance and cleaning preserve and maintain the appliance efficient for a longer period.



Risk of electric shock. All cleaning operations described below must be made with power off and the electrical plug disconnect from the power outlet.

If you drop or damage your product, do not use until it has been inspected by a qualified electrician

# **▲** CAUTION

Risk of burns. Each cleaning and maintenance operation should be performed when the unit is completely cooled.

There are no user serviceable parts inside this appliance.

#### Cleaning the fondue pot



Risk of electric shock. Don't immerse the fondue pot or the temperature probe in water.

# **A** CAUTION

Risk of material damage. Don't use aggressive products or solvents that may damage the plastic.

Remove the probe from the unit. Wash the appliance using a slightly wet, non-abrasive cloth, water and few drops of a non-aggressive product.

#### Cleaning the accessories



Never wash the accessories of the appliance in the dishwasher. Do not use direct jets of water.

All accessories in contact with food must be cleaned regularly, each time they are used. Wash the accessories with warm water and mild cleansers. Don't use abrasive sponges.



#### SETTING THE MACHINE OUT OF SERVICE

- Unplug the unit from the electric outlet.
- Cut the power cord.

In the case of decommissioning of the appliance, it must be electrically disconnected. To dispose of the appliance as a waste, cut the power cord.

In case of scrapping you will be required to separate the various materials used in the construction of the appliance and dispose of them according to their composition and to the applicable laws in the country of use.
