

# IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

# READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE

The necessary precautions must be taken when using electrical appliances, and these include the following:

- Make sure that the voltage on the appliance rating plate corresponds to that of the mains electricity.
- Never leave the appliance unattended when connected to the power supply; unplug it after every use.
- Never place the appliance on or close to sources of heat.
- 4. Always place the appliance on a flat, level surface during use.
- 5. Never leave the appliance exposed to the elements (rain, sun, etc....).
- Make sure that the power cord does not come into contact with hot surfaces.
- 7. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge only if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Do not allow children to play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance must not be carried out by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised.
- Children under age 8 should not be allowed to handle appliance and its power cord which must be kept out of their reach.
- 9. Never place the appliance body, plug

- or power cord in water or other liquids; always wipe clean with a damp cloth.
- Always unplug the power cord from the electricity mains before fitting or removing single attachments or before cleaning the appliance.
- Always make sure that your hands are thoroughly dry before using or adjusting the switches on the appliance, or before touching the power plug or power connections.
- To unplug the appliance, grip the plug and remove it directly from the power socket. Never pull the power cord to unplug the appliance.
- 13. Do not use the appliance if the power cord or plug are damaged or if the appliance itself is faulty; all repairs, including substitution of power cord, must be carried out exclusively by an Ariete assistance centre or by authorized Ariete technicians in order to avoid all risks.
- 14. Never allow the cord to dangle in places where it may be grabbed by a child.
- 15. Do not threaten the safety of the appliance by using parts that are not original or which have not been approved by the manufacturer.
- 16. In the event that you decide to dispose of the appliance, we advise you to make it inoperative by cutting off the power cord. We also recommend that any parts that could be dangerous be rendered harmless, especially for children, who may play with the appliance or its parts.
- Packaging must never be left within the reach of children since it is potentially dangerous.
- Toasted bread can burn; never use the toaster under or alongside flammable materials, such as curtains.
- Always handle the appliance with care during use and never touch the hot sides.
- 20. Do not place plates or other items on top of the toaster during use.
- 21. Do not place more than two slices in each slot.
- 22. Never insert forks or other utensils inside the toaster to remove the toast; this could damage the heating elements inside the appliance.
- Never place your hands or any other metal materials (for example, knives or tin foil) inside the toaster.
- Use the appliance well away from flammable liquids; do not rest it against walls, curtains or plastic parts that are not heat resistant.
- The appliance may only be wiped clean with a damp cloth and only after unplug-

- A ON lever
- B Toasting level adjustment knob
- C Heating button with integrated light
- D Defrosting button with integrated light
- E Stop button with integrated light
- F Crumb tray

# **OPERATION PRECAUTIONS**

- Do not use slices of bread that are too thin or broken.
- Do not insert foods that could drip during cooking. As well as making cleaning more difficult, these foods can also become the cause of fire. It is also very important to clean any food residues or crumbs from the crumb drawer (F) before each use.
- Do not insert food product that are too large by forcing them in.
- Do not put forks or other utensils inside the toaster to remove the bread since they could damage the resistors of the appliance. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCKS.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Keep the appliance on for a few minutes the first time it is used so as to get rid of the "new" odour and the fumes caused by the machining of the resistors.

Keep the original packing for future use if it should prove necessary. It is the best way to properly protect it from being damaged during transportation. Before using this product, be sure to carefully follow the instructions supplied in the section entitled "IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS".

#### **Preparing toast**

**WARNING**: Always allow at least 1 minute's cooling time between cycles if toaster is being used more than once at a time.

Put the slices of bread inside the slits of the toaster and lower the on lever (A) until it locks into place.

# Note: if the appliance is not plugged in, the lever does not lock.

Adjust the toasting lever with the knob (B). Wait a few minutes and after the toast is automatically ejected, check its toasting level. If the toast is not browned enough, select a higher toasting level. If, on the other hand, it is too dark, select a lower level.

Press the button (E) at any time to stop the toasting process.

Press the button (E) to turn the appliance off and disconnect the plug from the socket-outlet.

### Thawing function

You can toast frozen slices of bread by pressing the button (D) right after you lower the lever (A) and by setting the browning control knob (B) onto 1. If you wish to cook, rather than defrosting, the knob will have to be set onto darker settings (i.e. 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7). The light integrated in the button will stay on as long as the defrosting function is used.

#### **Heating function**

Lower the on lever (A) and press the heating button (C). The light integrated in the button will stay on as long as this function is used. Please note that the heating time is fixed and cannot be changed.

#### **CLEANING**

## It is severely forbidden to disassemble the appliance or to try in any way to work on it inside.

Keeping the appliance clean and tidy will ensure you will get optimum toasting and a longer lifetime of the appliance.

- Turn off the appliance by pressing the button (E) and remove the plug from the socket-outlet before you start to clean it
- Wait for the appliance to cool down before cleaning.
- Use only a slightly dampened cloth.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Always dry the appliance parts by hand without putting them in an oven or microwave.
- Never use sharp metal utensils for cleaning the interior of the appliance.
- Unplug the appliance and empty the crumb tray (F) after each use.

From time to time clean the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth and then dry. Do not use abrasive detergents since they could ruin the surface.



# 烤箱使用说明

使用前请阅读此说明 使用电器时必须采取必要的预防措 施,如下:

- 1. 确保本产品规定的电源电压与 供电电源电压相符。
- 2. 在无人值守的情况下请断开电 源:每次使用前请确保电源是 断开的。
- 3. 请勿将电器放置或靠近热源的 地方。
- 4. 请将设备放置于水平表面。
- 请勿将本产品遭受雨淋,日晒 等。
- 确保电源线不接触到热体表 面。
- 7. 本产品可供8岁(需在监管的 情况下)以上的人员使用,但 要保证他们知道如何正确的操 作并了解其中隐藏的危险,身 体感知能力较弱的儿童,或缺 乏相关经验和知识的人员,需 要由了解此设备的专业人员进 行指导。
- 8. 请勿让8岁以下的孩子接触设 备或电源线,请放置于儿童触 及不到的地方。

- 10. 在移动或清洗设备前必须拔掉 电源线,切断电源。


