



Danger for children

- Appliances can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory 1. or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and if they understand the hazards involved.
- This appliance shall not be used by children. Keep the appliance and its 2. cord out of reach of children. Children shall not play with the appliance.
- 3. Never allow the cord to dangle in places where it may be grabbed by a child.
- 4. When disposing of the appliance as waste, it must be made inoperative by cutting off the power cord. Also remember to make any potentially hazardous parts of the appliance safe including the power cord, as

there is a risk that children may use them as playthings.

5. Packaging elements must not be left in reach of children as they are potentially hazardous.



Danger from electricity

- 6. Make sure that the voltage on the appliance rating plate corresponds to that of your local mains electricity supply.
- 7. Never leave the appliance unattended when connected to the power supply; unplug it after every use.
- 8. Make sure that the power cord does not come into contact with hot or sharp surfaces.
- 9. It is not recommended to use this appliance in conjunction with an extension cord.



Danger from other causes

- 10. Always unplug the power cord from the mains supply before fitting or removing attachments or before cleaning the appliance.
- 11. Always make sure that your hands are thoroughly dry before using or adjusting the controls on the appliance, or before touching the power plug or power connections.
- 12. Do not transport the appliance while it is operating.
- 13. During operation, the metal parts and glass become hot: only touch the door handle or user control knobs at this time.
- 14. Use the appliance well away from flammable liquids; do not rest it against walls, curtains or plastic parts that are not heat resistant.
- 15. The appliance may only be wiped clean with a damp cloth and only after unplugging it from the mains and leaving it to cool completely.
- 16. After use, wait for the appliance to cool completely before storing.
- 17. This appliance may not be operated using external timers or remote controls.

Important, Possible damage to materials

- 18. Place the Oven on a work top or kitchen cabinet capable of withstanding a temperature of at least 90°C and leave some room above it. Under no circumstances should it be slotted in or inserted into a unit.
- 19. Remove all internal accessories, then wash and dry with care.
- 20. Do not cover the inside parts of the Oven with aluminium foil as this could seriously damage thermostat operation.
- 21. Do not place anything on the door when it is open.
- 22. Do not place dish cloths or plates on the appliance.
- 23. Only use the appliance for cooking purposes.
- 24. Do not allow acidic substances (lemon juice, vinegar, etc.) to remain on the appliance. If left for long periods acidic substances, such as lemon juice, tomato sauce, vinegar or similar, may harm the enamel, causing it to lose its shine.
- 25. Never place the appliance on or close to sources of heat.
- 26. Always place the appliance on a flat, level and heat resistant surface during use.
- 27. Never leave the appliance exposed to the elements (rain, sun, etc...).
- 28. Never immerse the appliance body, plug or power cord in water or other liquids; always wipe clean with a damp cloth only.
- 29. To unplug the appliance, grip the plug and remove it directly from the power socket. Never pull the power cord to unplug the appliance.
- 30. Do not use the appliance if the power cord or plug are damaged or if the appliance itself is faulty; all repairs, including the replacement of the power cord, must be carried out exclusively by the After Sales Support centre or by authorised technicians in order to avoid all risks.
- 31. Do not affect the safety of the appliance by using parts that are not original or which have not been approved by the manufacturer. Risk of electrocution or injury.
- 32. Any changes to this product that have not been expressly authorised by the manufacturer may lead to the user's warranty being rendered null and void.









Instructions for use Mini Oven

USING FOR THE FIRST TIME

Carry out an "empty" cooking cycle so as to remove any residual smell and smoke from the protective coatings applied to metal parts during the manufacturing process:

- switch on the Oven by turning the "Function Select" dial (H) to the symbol []; set the temperature to the maximum by turning the "Thermostat" dial (G) and the "Power and Timer" dial (L) to 15 minutes;
- leave the appliance to operate with the door open in a well-aired environment. During this operation, it is usual for smoke to come off metal parts and from side openings. After this operation, ventilate the room.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Prepare the foods for cooking by placing them on the grill (C) or inside the drip pan (D).
- Plug the appliance into the mains power and use the function select dial (H) to select the type of cooking required:

top cooking (for gratin);
bottom cooking;
cooking at full power (top and bottom at the same time).

- Turn the dial of the thermostat (G) and set the required cooking temperature.
- Place the grill (C) with the previously prepared food into the Oven at the required cooking level (E), by using the supplied Grill Handle (M) (Fig. 2). In case of food prepared in the drip pan (D), insert the grill (C) into the Oven first, and then position the drip pan itself on it (D) (Fig. 3).

ATTENTION

The drip pan is smaller than the grill, and needs to be placed on top of the grill to be placed on the grill to provide support. Never put the drip pan in direct contact with the heating elements.

CAUTION

Place foods at a minimum distance of 2 cm from the top heating element.

Use the dial (L) to set the timer to the required cooking time.



At this stage, the Oven starts cooking and the temperature light (I) switches on; it switches on and off automatically as the set temperature is maintained.

The cooking process will stop and the indicator extinguish if the dial (L) is manually reset to "0" position or if the dial (H) is manually reset to the symbol \square .

CAUTION

Keep an eye on the food while it is cooking.

- At the end of the cooking time, the Oven stops automatically, sending out an alarm.
- Unplug the appliance, open the door and remove the grill (C) or the drip pan (D) using suitable Oven gloves or the appropriate grill handle (M) supplied.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

CAUTION

It is forbidden to disassemble the appliance or to try in any way to undertake any maintenance work on the appliance other than as described in this manual.

ATTENTION

All removable enamelled parts need to be washed with soapy water or other non-abrasive products.

- Frequent cleaning prevents the formation of smoke and unpleasant odours during cooking.
- The drip pan (D) and the grill (C) can be washed in warm soapy water or in the top rack of the dishwasher.
- Always wipe the outside clean with a damp sponge. Do not use abrasive products that can damage the paintwork.
- Never use products that might corrode aluminium (spray detergents) to clean the inside surfaces and never scrape the sides with sharp or pointed objects. Wipe with a damp sponge at the end of each use, when the Oven has completely cooled.
- When there are grease spots or smoke exhalations, we recommend removing grease with a sponge soaked in hot soapy water.

WARNING

Never immerse the appliance body, plug or power cord in water or other liquids.











ATTENTION

Dry with a soft cloth. Acidic substances such as lemon juice, tomato purée, vinegar or similar can damage the enamel, making it lose shine.

*All cooking times are approx. Always read the instructions on the food label.

Hot Dog	200°	2	6-10 min.
Hamburger	230°	2	10-14 min.

DISPOSAL OF WASTE




The product packaging is made of recyclable materials. The packaging material can be taken to public recycling collection points.
