


AUTOMATIC CITRUS JUICER

Assembly

Place the juice container on the motor base, then rest the reamer in the juice container.

Note: Model JE150 also has a clear cover **(A).**

Cord Storage (B)

Unwanted cord can be wound around the motor base and secured in the slot provided.

To Operate

Cut the citrus fruit (lemons, oranges, grapefruit and limes) in half horizontally. Take each half and press down on the reamer, the motor will automatically start. When the juice has been extracted, lift the fruit from the reamer and the motor will stop. The juice will flow into the juice container leaving the seeds, pips and pulp behind. To serve simply remove the combined reamer and strainer from the collecting vessel and pour out the juice.

Note: The reamer will operate in a clockwise or anti-clockwise direction.

Capacity

Model JE 100 - 9 fl.ozs Model JE 150 - 24 fl.ozs

Once the juice container is full, it should be emptied, and the pulp, seeds etc removed from the combined reamer and strainer. Once this has been carried out the juicing operation can continue.

Important

To avoid overheating do not press too hard on the reamer and do not operated continuously for more than 10 minutes at a time

Cleaning

Always unplug the unit before cleaning. The combined reamer and strainer, and juice container may be washed in warm soapy water. The motor base needs only to be wiped over with a damp cloth.

Do not immerse in water.

This appliance is for household use only.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS
