



Intended use

- The window vacuum cleaner is suitable for cleaning wet, smooth glass or mirror surfaces or tiles only.
 It is designed to vacuum a liquid quantity of up to 150 ml.
- Only use the window vacuum cleaner in combination with standard glass/ window cleaning products. Never vacuum up methylated spirits, highlyconcentrated alcohol solutions, foam cleaners, or any caustic or flammable chemicals, etc.
- The window vacuum cleaner is not suitable for vacuuming up dust or small objects!
- The product is suitable for private use and is not suitable for commercial purposes.

WARNING - hazards resulting from misuse

- Never vacuum up the following:
- dry dust;
- glowing ash, cigarette butts, matchsticks, etc.: fire hazard!
- flammable or combustible materials;

- Wipe off the handheld unit with a slightly dampened cloth. No moisture should get into the ventilation slots or the connection socket.
- 5. Leave all parts to dry completely before reassembling the window vacuum cleaner.

Storing the vacuum cleaner

Cleaning and storage

Cleaning the spray bottle

 Open the Velcro® fastener and remove the microfibre pad from the holder.



2. Press the ribbed areas on the sides and pull off the holder for the microfibre pad.

- 3. Unscrew the spray head from the bottle and rinse the bottle and all parts with clear water to remove any leftover cleaning solution.
- 4. Leave the parts to dry before putting the spray bottle back together and storing it away.

Cleaning the microfibre pad

➤ The microfibre pads can be washed in the washing machine at max. 40°C.

Take note of the care symbols on the sewn-in label.



DANGER - risk of fatal electric shock

- Do not immerse the handheld unit of the vacuum cleaner in water or other liquids. No moisture should get into the ventilation slots.
- Disconnect the appliance from the mains power if necessary and close the connection socket with its cover before cleaning the appliance.

The appliance must be switched off and disconnected from the mains power.



- 1. Remove the suction nozzle by pressing the ribbed area and pulling the suction nozzle smoothly off the handheld unit at the same time.
- 2. Rinse the suction nozzle off under running water. Then leave the nozzle to dry completely.
- Empty and clean the water tank as described in the section "Emptying the water tank" in the chapter "Use".

DANGER to children and people with restricted capabilities of operating appliances

- While the window vacuum cleaner is suitable for vacuuming liquid, do not immerse it completely in water or any other liquids as there is otherwise a risk of electric shock.
- Only use the mains adapter provided to charge the product.

- Do not charge the product outdoors or in rooms with high humidity.
- Never touch the mains adapter with damp hands when plugging it in or unplugging it.
- The connecting cord of the mains adapter must not be kinked or squeezed. Keep the connecting cord away from hot surfaces and sharp edges.
- Keep sufficient distance to sources of heat such as hobs or ovens while the appliance is charging.
- Only connect the mains adapter to a properly installed wall socket with a voltage that complies with the technical specifications of the mains adapter.
- Ensure that the wall socket is easily accessible, so that the mains adapter can be disconnected quickly if need be. Route the connecting cord in such a way that no one can trip over it.
- Remove the mains adapter from the socket...
- ... if disturbances occur while charging,
- ... once the appliance is fully charged,
- ... during thunderstorms and
- ... before using or cleaning the appliance.

Always pull on the mains adapter, not on the connecting cord.

- After charging, always close the connection socket with its cover.
- Disconnect the window vacuum cleaner from the mains power before using or cleaning the appliance.
- Do not use the window vacuum cleaner if the appliance itself or the mains adapter show any sign of damage or if the appliance has been dropped.
- Only use the window vacuum cleaner when it is fully assembled. The suction nozzle and water tank must be correctly inserted and locked in place.
- Do not make any modifications to the product. The rechargeable battery is firmly built into the window vacuum cleaner and cannot be replaced. Only have repairs to the appliance or the mains adapter carried out by a specialist workshop, or contact the customer service. If the connecting cord is damaged the mains adapter must be replaced.
- Do not clean any electronic devices with the spray bottle. Do not aim it at people or animals.

WARNING - fire hazard

 The window vacuum cleaner contains a built-in lithium-ion rechargeable battery. The rechargeable battery must not be removed, taken apart, thrown into fire or short-circuited.

- Do not cover the ventilation slots on the side of the window vacuum cleaner while it is in use. Risk of overheating!
- Do not use the appliance in the vicinity of highly flammable materials. Do not vacuum up sharp-edged objects or highly flammable substances such as matches or ashes. Do not use the appliance to vacuum up small objects.

CAUTION - material damage

- The water tank is designed to hold approx. 150 ml. If the **MAX** mark is exceeded, dirty water may leak out. Therefore, check and empty the tank regularly while using the appliance.
- Protect the appliance from impacts, falls, dust, extreme temperatures and other weather conditions (rain, strong sunlight, etc.).
- Do not use the window vacuum cleaner on rough surfaces. Doing so could damage the rubber edges.
- Do not insert any objects into the openings on the appliance.
- Do not store the appliance outside or in rooms with high humidity, e.g. in the cellar or garage.
- Do not use abrasive or caustic products, or hard brushes, etc. for cleaning the appliance.
- Only use the original attachments.



- 1. Place the window vacuum cleaner onto the damp surface with the handheld unit upright and press the on/off switch (1) to switch the appliance on.
 - The indicator light lights up red.
- 2. With a little pressure, pull the suction nozzle over the surface from top to bottom to wipe away the dirty water and vacuum it up at the same time. Do not do any circular or horizontal motions as otherwise the dirty water already collected in the water tank may leak out!
- 3. To switch the appliance off after use, press the on/off switch (1).



if the dirty water has reached the MAX mark on the water tank. If so, the water tank must be emptied.

Emptying the water tank





1. Tilt the water tank downwards at a slight angle to release it from the handheld unit.



2. Remove the cover and pour the dirty water away. Then briefly rinse the tank out with clear water.



3. Press the cover back onto the opening of the empty tank as far as it will go. The arrows must be facing each other.




4. Place the water tank onto the bottom of the handheld unit at a slight downward angle...




5. ... and press it upwards firmly onto the unit. You should hear and feel it click into place.

Applying the cleaning solution

1. With the spray bottle, spray the cleaning solution onto the surface you want to clean.

You can choose between a simple stream of water (STREAM) or a fine spray mist (SPRAY). Turn the nozzle on the spray head to the position you want to use.

In the **OFF** position the nozzle is closed.

2. In circular motions, wipe the microfibre pad over the whole surface to remove any dirt.





Charging the window vacuum cleaner's battery

fully charged upon delivery. To reach the battery's maximal charging capacity, charge the appliance up fully before using it for the first time. The first charge will take approx. 24 hours.



The vacuum cleaner must be switched off for charging.



- 1. Insert the small plug on the charging cable into the socket at the bottom of the appliance.
- 2. Insert the mains adapter into a wall socket.

The indicator light flashes red while it is charging.

Once the indicator light goes out, the battery is fully charged.

- 3. Disconnect the mains adapter from the wall socket.
- The built-in rechargeable battery is not 4. Remove the charging cable from the appliance and close the connection socket again with its cover.

The operating time of the window vacuum cleaner with a fully charged battery is approx. 40 minutes.


The battery must be charged again when the indicator light starts to flash slowly during use. If the rechargeable battery is not charged, the appliance will automatically switch itself off after a certain time.



- The window vacuum cleaner becomes warm while charging. This is normal and not a fault.
- To keep the full charging capacity of the battery, only charge the window vacuum cleaner when the battery is flat and the appliance has switched itself off automatically.
- Charge the battery in an environment between +10 and +40°C.






 Do not pour any boiling cleaning solutions into the spray bottle.

CAUTION - material damage

 Do not pour any methylated spirits, foam cleaners, or other chemicals into the spray bottle. These substances must not be vacuumed up by the window vacuum cleaner!

Use a standard glass/window cleaning product.

We recommend: Pour in 50 ml glass cleaner and then slowly fill the bottle up with clear water.



1. Fill the cleaning solution into the bottle and screw the spray head onto the bottle again. The ring ensures that the spray head will not accidentally come loose during use.
