IMPORTANT WARNINGS

The following safety measures should be adopted when using electrical appliances:

- 1 Ensure that the electrical voltage of the appliance corresponds with that of your electricity supply.
- 2 Never leave the appliance unattended when it is connected to the electricity supply; unplug after use.
- 3 This appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons without supervision.
- 4 Do not place the appliance over or near a source of heat.
- 5 Do not allow the power cord to touch hot surfaces.
- 6 NEVER IMMERSE THE POWER UNIT, PLUG AND POWER CORD IN WATER OR OTHER LIQUIDS. Use a damp cloth to clean them, then dry thoroughly.
- 7 NEVER TOUCH THE MOVING PARTS.
- 8 Do not operate the appliance when it is empty.
- 9 Never fill the food bowl with liquids.
- 10 The appliance should not be used for food with a hard or touch consistency (e.g.: ice cubes or meat with bones).
- 11 Never use a damaged machine. Get it checked or repaired at your nearest authorised Service Centre.
- 12 If the power cord is damaged it must for safety reasons be replaced by an authorised repairer, in order to prevent any risk.
- 13 This appliance has been designed for DOMESTIC USE ONLY and should not be used for commercial or industrial purposes.
- 14 This appliance complies with European Economic Community Directive 89/336/EEC.
- 15 The blades are sharp, handle with care. Hold at the top away from the cutting edge, both when inserting or removing it from the bowl and when cleaning.
- 16 Wait for the blade to stop completely before removing the cover.
- 17 Young children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with this appliance.
- 18 Various spices such as cloves, dill and cumin seeds have an adverse effect on the bowl plastic and should not be processed.
- 19 Care is needed when handling cutting blades, especially when removing the blade from the bowl, emptying the bowl and during cleaning.
- 20 Accessories, other than those provided with the appliance, if any, shall include instructions for their safe use with the appliance.
- 21 Warning: Switch off the appliance before changing accessories or approaching parts

Compact and convenient, your food chopper will become an irreplaceable help in the kitchen:

- 1. simple and easy to use thanks to its one-handed operation.
- 2. ideal for large quantities and instant food preparation.
- 3. essential for quickly chopping parsley, garlic, onions, meat, vegetables, hard cheese, dried fruit.
- 4. safe, because it only functions when the cover is properly fitted.
- 5. easy to put away due to the sucker that holds the wrapped cord in place.
- 6. easy to clean, simply three pieces.

DESCRIPTION OF THE APPLIANCE

- A. power unit
- B. drive shaft
- C. food bowl
- **D.** knife blade
- E. switch
- F. cover
- G. power cord plug

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Place bowl (C) on power unit (A) and knife blade (D) on drive shaft (B). Ensure that the knife blade clicks into place.
- Cut the food to be chopped into small pieces (1,5 x 1,5 cm) and place inside the bowl. Do not place more than 200 g. of meat into the bowl, do not run the appliance for more than 20 seconds.
- 3. Place cover (F) on power unit (A).
- 4. Plug power cord (G) into the electricity supply.
- 5. Start the appliance by pressing down on switch (E) with the palm of the hand. The appliance performs best when a start-stop action is employed – intermittently press down on the switch for a very short time (2-3 seconds).
- If the appliance does not function, make sure that some food has not fallen into the gap between the cover and the edge of the bowl (C).
- 7. A fine chopped result is obtained by scraping the food on the sides of the bowl to the centre by means of a spatula.
- Never add liquids to combine the chopped food
- 9. When mincing meat, use a maximum of 200 grams of meat cut into small pieces. This speeds up the mincing process. Never use the appliance for more than 10 seconds at a time for three consecutive cycles. Leave to cool for at least two minutes between two consecutive cycles.
- 10. After three operations as described in point 9, allow the appliance to cool down to room temperature.

AFTER USE

- Unplug the power cord from the electricity supply.
- Remove the cover (F) by lifting it upwards.
- Remove the knife blade (D), remove the bowl(C).
- If the appliance has been used for a long time and no longer chops in a satisfactory manner, the blade must be replaced.

CLEANING

- The bowl (C), cover (F) and knife blade (D) may be washed in the top part of the dishwasher.
- Use a damp cloth to clean the power unit. Dry thoroughly.
- Do not use abrasive cloths and detergents.
- The appliance may be stored with the power cord wrapped around the power unit, with the cord held in place by means of the sucker.
